

St. Paul Pre-K: Week #5 Continuous Learning Packets. These items will be in your packet for the week of May 4, 2020. I do not need anything returned to me. If the activity is too hard for your student, please feel free to do it with them. Remember, your child is 4 and shouldn't sit for long periods of time.

Alphabet Knowledge: The letter Yy. Yellow Yo-yo Man is our Letterland Character for the letter Y. Yellow Yo-yo Man's action is to move your hand up and down as if controlling a yo-yo. Formation of the letter Y begins at the top line. Go down diagonal slightly right to the middle line. Pick up your pencil and start at the top line again. Go down diagonal slightly left to meet the first line at the middle. You child may go straight down from there to the bottom line. They may also choose to continue to the bottom line with a diagonal stroke.

The Letter Xx. Fix-it Max is our other Letterland Character for the letter Xx. Fix-it Max's action is to cross your arms across your chest in an x-shape. Formation of the letter X begins at the top and goes diagonal to the bottom line. Students may choose to add a monkey tail so he doesn't fall over. Pick up your pencil and move back to the top line to the right and cross diagonal down through the middle line to end at the bottom line left.

Fun with our letters of the week. Packet "Y is for yum!" Letter Yy review, yummy patterns, finding Y, What do you think is yummy?, find the yummy letter trail, smallest to biggest, Upper/Lowercase Y, fine motor tracing, and draw something you think is yummy.

Packet "X is for x-ray." Letter Xx review, letter formation/tracing, Capital/Lower case Letter Match, find X and underline it, Left-to-Right Progressioni, and color by number.

Math: Number 20- Trace, color and count.

Counting Bears Game: Practice counting with your child. Use buttons, rocks, small toys, anything your child has to count the number on the bears' tummy.

Science: My Big World Scholastic News. "Splish Splash Summer." All about summing and safety. Phonological awareness activity on the back. Circling "S" words.
