



Chetopa/St. Paul Back to School Daily Operations Guide



Health and Hygiene



Masks are required per Governor's Executive Order 20-59.

Mask covering consists of appropriate cloth material worn over the nose and mouth.

Masks are required for students on the school bus, when working one-on-one with teachers, and in the school office.

Classrooms will be sanitized between classes.

Home health screening is required before school. Do not send students to school, who have an unmedicated temperature of 100.4 degrees or higher, or other related symptoms. We encourage siblings of students with high temperature (100.4) to remain at home as well.

School health screenings will be administered prior to students being permitted to load onto the bus or enter the school building.

Safe distancing will be administered for preventive measures by utilizing smaller class sizes, making necessary changes to learning spaces, and staggering bathroom breaks and schedules.



Safe distancing and facilities

Safe distancing of 6 ft. whenever possible. Regular cleaning of high touch areas.

Drinking fountains off-limits. Student water bottles permitted. Bottle filling stations will be provided.

Academics



Appropriate technology will be provided specifically to the academic needs of students.

Expectations for student learning and attendance will be consistent regardless of the learning platform.



Cafeterias and dining spaces

Hand washing before/after eating and before handling silverware.

All food handed to students, no self-serve/no salad bar.

Elementary students will have assigned seats at lunch.

Closed lunches as recommended by KSDE guidance document.

No outside delivering of lunches or sharing lunches



Transportation

Parents are responsible for student supervision until the school health screening is complete.

Masks are required for students and drivers while traveling in school transportation.

Assigned bus seats for students. Siblings will be grouped together.

Hand sanitizer added to all school transportation.

Parents will remain in vehicles during drop off and pick-up.

Parents should maintain social distancing while waiting for students to exit the building after school.



Visitors

Visitors are encouraged to contact the office prior to a visit.

Visitors will remain in the foyer.

No classroom treats.

Mask required for all during parent meetings.

Health assessment required, mask required.

Classrooms and learning spaces



Hand sanitizer will be available in every classroom and high traffic areas.

Frequent hand washing/sanitation will be a routine expectation.



Recess

Recess allowed with enhanced cleaning. Scheduled recess times with smaller numbers of students; safe distancing encouraged.

Students will wash or sanitize hands at the beginning and end of recess.
