Others present: Craig Bagshaw, Superintendent; Josh Brennon, District technology; Jolene Hall, Chetopa K-12 principal; Keaton McCracken, St. Paul K-12 principal; and Terri Ross, clerk.

A motion, "I make a motion to approve the agenda as presented" was made by Kari Chambers and seconded by Brad Harris. The motion passed, 5-0.

The consent agenda included the minutes of the January 16, 2023 meeting; February bills; January VISA bill; and January activity accounts. A motion, "I make a motion to approve the consent agenda as presented" was made by Kari Chambers and seconded by Barbara Evans. The motion passed, 5-0.

Under SEK reports, Roberta Carter reported: demolition at TLC will be started over spring break and the new social security teacher was impressed by the video that Keaton had made.

Under technology, Josh Brennon reported: purchased iPad cases; replaced a monitor; TEC finished at Chetopa and will start at St. Paul tomorrow; and problems with no internet in Chetopa because of At&t.

Under principal reports, Mrs. Hall's report included: dishwasher is finally working; first grade received anonymous donations of toiletries for students; received \$389.91 from the Knights of Columbus; Creative Corner is having a mural contest; Cowboy Church donated toiletries for several students; Stuco students went to listen to Damon Parker, a motivational speaker sponsored by Independence Community College; FCCLA sold cookies for Valentine's Day; JH and HS working on IPS; FFA next week; working on plans for a retirement party for Alan Paxson; March 7 is career day at PSU and we have promotional items to hand out; JH basketball is done; HS boys are improving; 25 kids signed up for pink night; a Sweetheart dance will be held on the 25th for the elementary and junior high; finishing evaluations and have been stressing attendance; and HS scholar bowl received 4th. A motion, “I make a motion to adjourn” was made by Seth Born and seconded by Kari Chambers. The motion passed, 5-0. The meeting adjourned at 8:26 PM.
